Read 1 Corinthians 9:19-23

1. How does Paul's background help him live these verses out? (If you don't know Paul's background see Philippians 3:4-11; Acts 26)
2. What does he mean in verses 19-22? How do you think he would do that?
3. What is his motivation?
4. Do you think Paul loses his identity if he changes to reach different groups? How is he able to do this?
5. Have you ever struggled with your identity in the society around us?

6. Upper left corner: A characteristic of your family/parents that you most admire
7. Upper right corner: The part of your personality/character that you're most proud of
8. Lower left corner: The most formative experience you've had in the past few years
9. Lower right corner: One issue/idea/belief that you care about more than any other.

Share the different elements of your family crest with the others in your group. In what ways can the different parts of this crest help you in our mission to the world?
