MISSING PIECE, MISSING PEACE

Read John 6:25-40

1. Why are the Jews looking for Jesus? What do they want from Him?
2. When do we seek Jesus out and what do we want from Him?
3. Why do they ask him for a sign? What sign do you think they expect?
4. How does Jesus respond to their request? What is he trying to convey to them?
5. What promises are there for us in this passage?

Read John 14:27 and Philippians 4:6-7

6. What does Jesus mean when he says "I do not give to you as the world gives"?
7. How does our understanding of God affect our experience of His peace?

Spend sometime praying alone or with someone else regarding those 'hungers' (desires / needs / things in life you feel would complete you) that you don't feel (or struggle to trust that) God can meet.

Leaders Notes

These notes are here as guidelines or commentary notes to help the leader. Let the Word of God lead you and your Lifegroup to HEAR God's prophetic message this week as you explore His Word together.

A little context regarding John 6:25-40

Prior to this passage Jesus has miraculously fed over 5000 people with just two fish and five loaves of bread. He then crossed a lake from where they were in the middle of the night and in the morning the people went looking for Jesus and in this passage they have just found Him.

Manna - in the old testament God rescued the Jewish people from slavery in Egypt. He took them on a journey to a new land to begin a new life; on the way the people had no food so God sent manna for them to eat. Every morning the Jewish people would find manna on the ground for them to collect and eat. It is sometimes referred to as the "bread from heaven". Manna shows God's provision for his people -a miracle showing his grace and love to them. It is a key event in an important section of the Jewish history (see Exodus 16).
