8. Has your definition and view of faith shifted during this exploration of our church theme "faith" so far? How so? Or not?
9. What does it mean to be a man of faith / woman of faith? How can we strive to become one?
10. In your experience, how do you practically increase your faith? And do you think this is necessary for spiritual growth?
11. Faith, hope and love — which do you need God to work on in your life the most? Why?
12. In your opinion, how do you balance having faith and having expectations of God answering our prayers, but remaining realistic?
13. What has been the most craziest miracle you have ever heard about or experienced?
