<p>Exodus 20</p> <p>setting the culture apart from the surrounding cultures.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Social action -Family Concern -Relationship with God -One God -Uselessness of idols -No sacrificing babies -Love 		
<p>LEVITICUS</p> <p>Exodus gave the directions for building the tabernacle, and now Leviticus gives the laws for worship, including instructions on ceremonial cleanness, moral laws, holy days, sabbath year, and year of jubilee. Leviticus focuses on holiness - holiness of God and man.</p>		
<p>NUMBERS</p> <p>Numbers presents an account of the 38 years Israel wandered in the desert. It is God shaping and moulding the people through experiences and trials to build faith, relationship, and reliance on God.</p>		
<p>DEUTERONOMY</p> <p>This is basically Moses recounting everything he said earlier as a deathbed writing. Deuteronomy means "copy (repetition) of the law" Moses emphasises the covenant and relationship with the Lord to the people before he passes away.</p>		
<p>TEACHING</p> <p>God teaching his people about worship, about the temple, about space, about relationship, about obedience, about forgiveness, about sin... step by step - preparing them for the future : boot camp</p>
