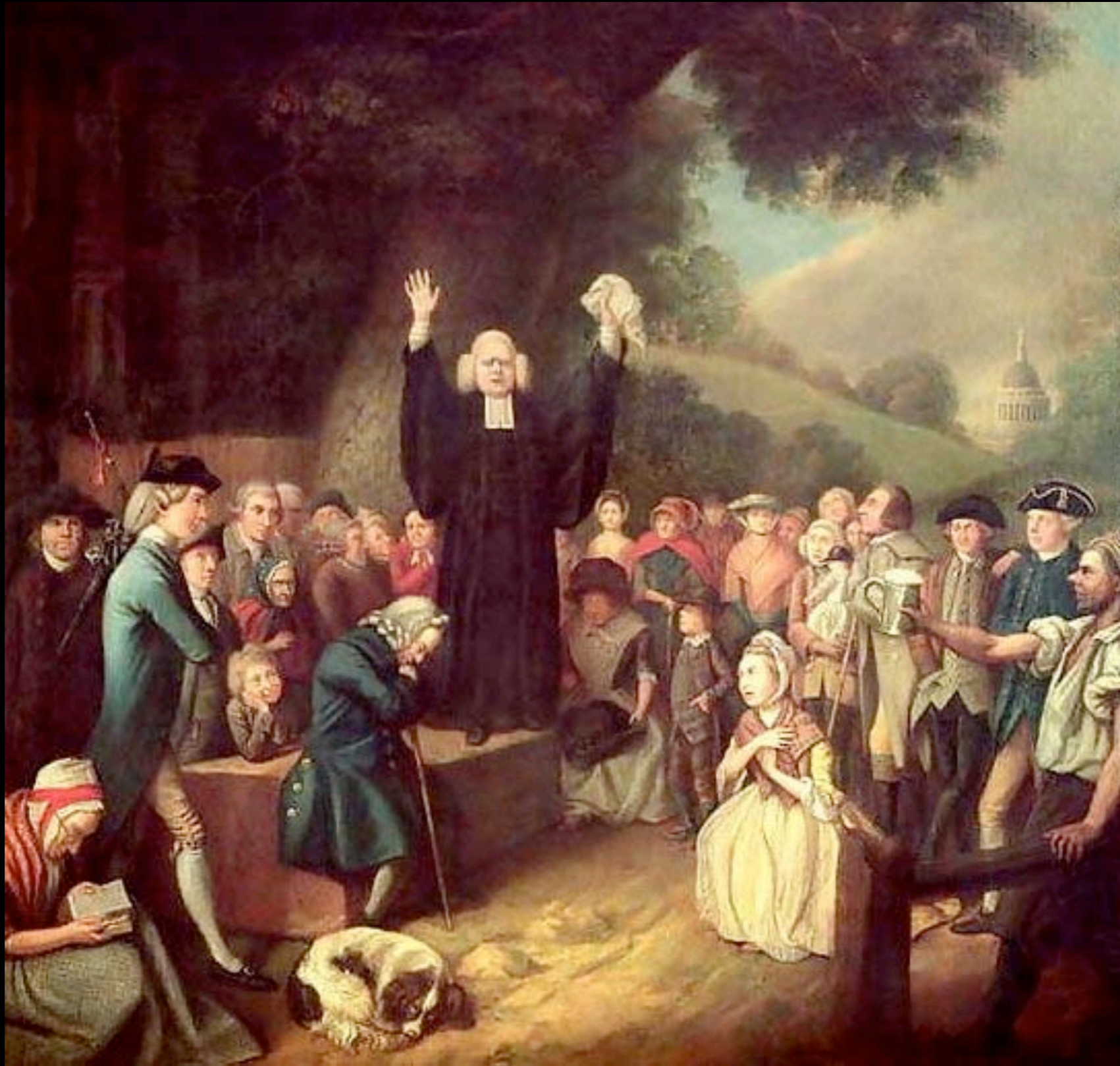

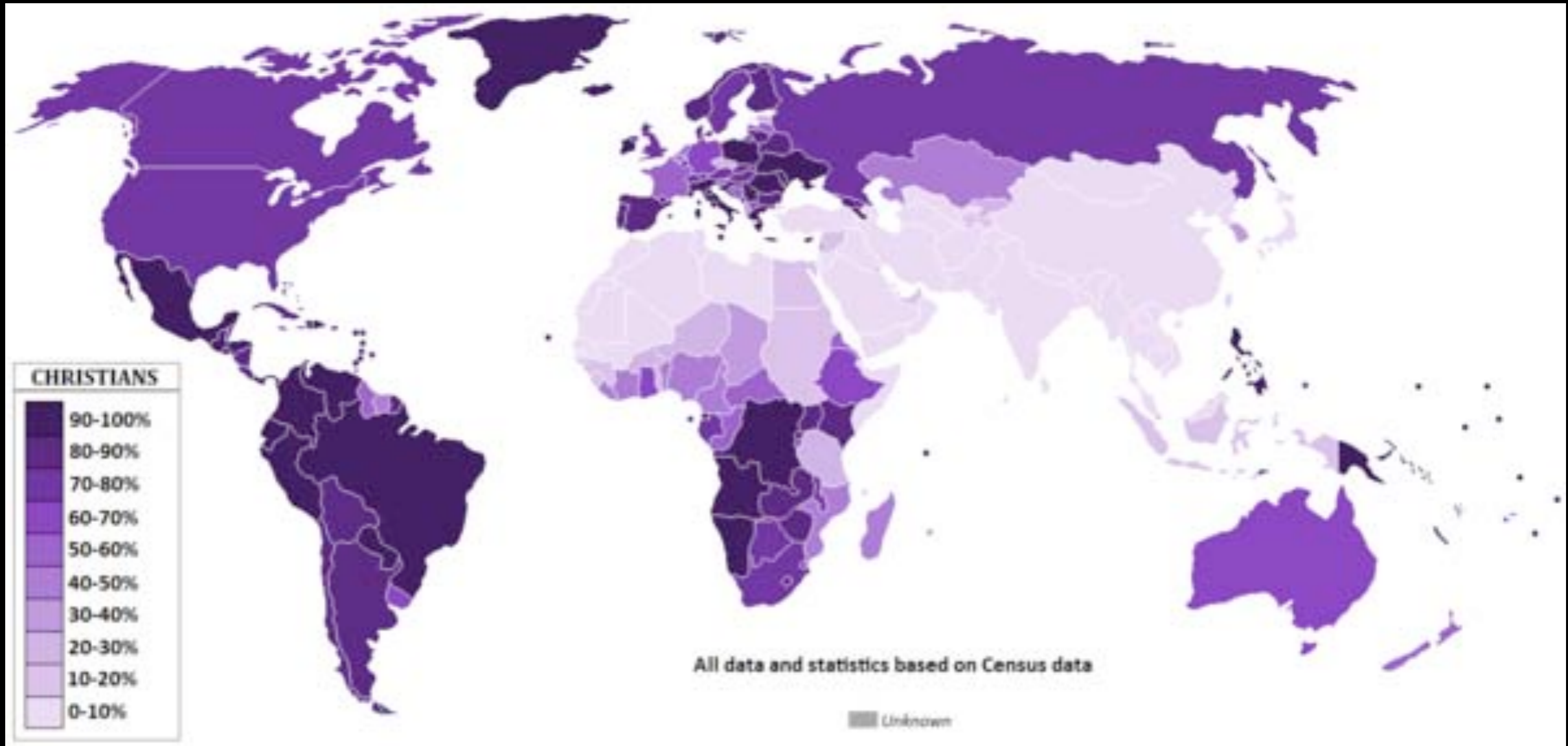

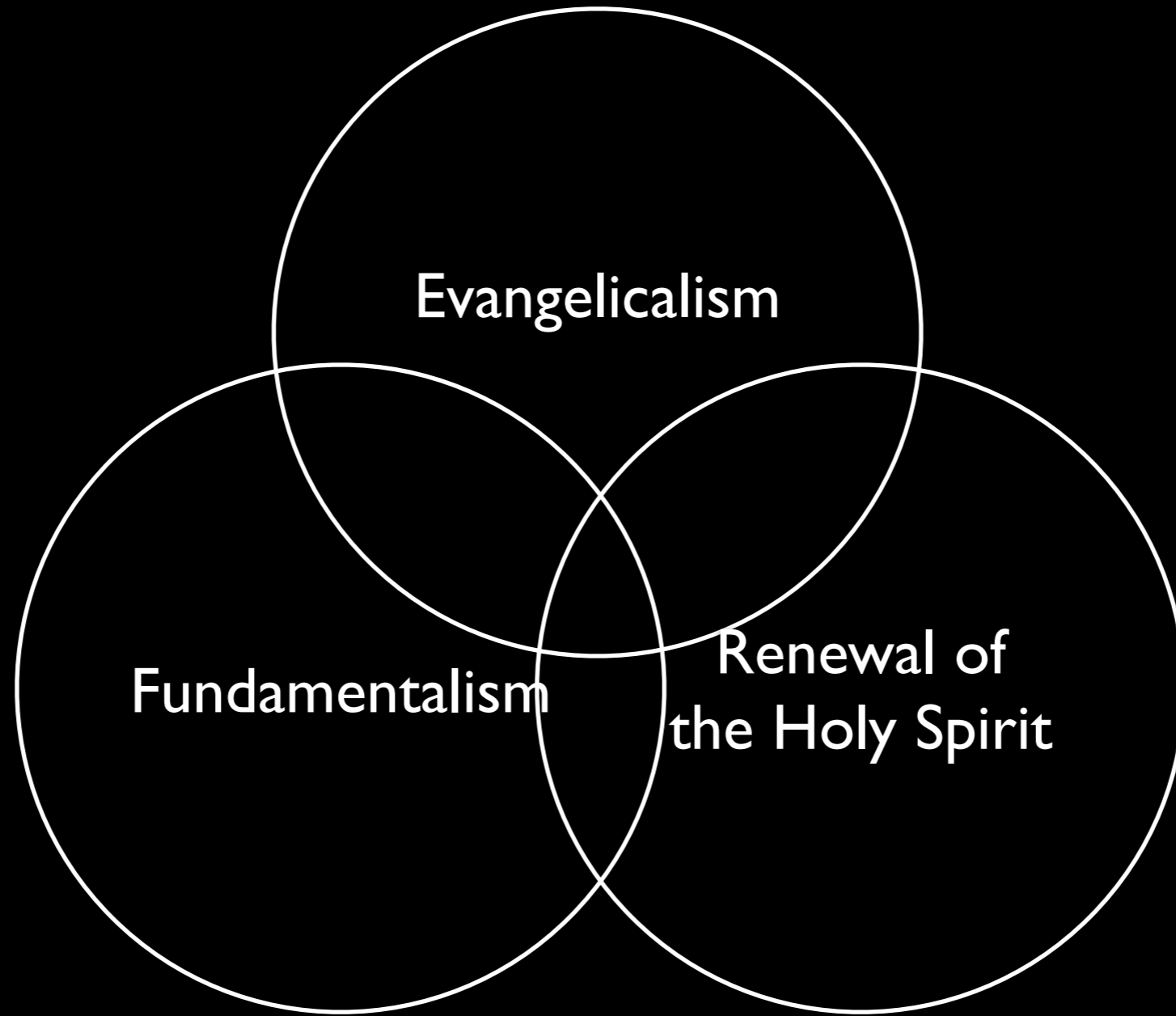


The Second Great Awakening



“Evangelicalism” Defined

<i>Crucicentrism</i>	Christ’s death crucial for atonement
<i>Biblicism</i>	Bible is primary source of spiritual truth
<i>Conversionism</i>	Following Jesus changes our lives
<i>Activism</i>	Local and foreign missions
