

Alone vs. Lonely


Alone adj, adv EXTERNAL separated, no one around you, in a physical sense

Examples:

"I need to be <u>alone</u> to revise" "When her parents got home she was <u>alone</u> in her room studying"

Lonely adj INTERNAL separated and affected; causing a you to feel unhappy, isolation in an emotional sense.

"Frank is a very <u>lonely</u> guy"
"He started feeling <u>lonely</u>
after moving to Japan, so he
decided to come back home."
