Warming Up... <i>"Friendship arises when companions discover that they have in common some insight or interest"—C.S. Lewis</i> What are some common things that connect you with your friends? What do you think helps people become friends?	Aims & Objectives of today's session: - To have examine our friendships and to see how we might deepen them.
Part 1: Power of Partnership Read Luke 10:1-2 1. Why do you think Jesus sent them out 2 by 2? 2. What are some ways teamwork is important in reaching those around us? Part 2: Urgent Harvest 3. Jesus says to "ask the Lord of the harvest to send workers". Why do you think he says that? Why do we need to ask God to send more workers? 4. Why do you think Jesus emphasizes the lack of workers rather than the difficulty of the mission? Part 3: Successful Mission 5. Jesus says the harvest is plentiful. But in your experience have you found it easy to bring people to knowing Jesus? What are some challenges you face? 6. The passage emphasizes that it's God's mission (see what parts of the verses emphasises God's in control). Our responsibility is being obedient and faithful. 7. Evangelism is a journey, and we harvest at the right time. Look at the attached document : The Engels Scale 8. For your friends who don't know Jesus yet, where do you think they are on the scale? What parts can you play in helping them move forward in their relationship with God.	Notes for Leader * Friendships requires effort and intentionality – Because friendship is not based on obligation (like family) or necessity (like survival), it requires effort to maintain. True friends must choose to invest time, care, and attention to keep their bond strong. * The friends show great faith in desiring to get the paralysed man to see Jesus. * The Pharisees were more focused on the theology as opposed to the healing. Sometimes those things can affect our friendships. Homework / Challenge for this week Spend time in prayer this week specifically asking God to send more workers into His harvest field. Ask Him to show you your role as well. Ending with prayer Jesus, thank you for the friendship we have with you. Teach me to be a friend to others.

This scale shows a series of decisive steps that a person goes through in a process towards or away from Christ. Whereas God's work initially is to show Himself through general revelation (that is, through nature and logic), He begins the work of convicting an individual as Christians proclaim of God to others. Yet for many who do not know Christ, there is often a point in which they are challenged and need to make a decision to act upon the Gospel message. If the individual is unwilling to embrace with faith the Gospel at this point, he or she often will regress and struggle once again with the implications of the Gospel. But when a person chooses to make a decision to repent and embrace the Gospel message, he or she is justified and new birth occurs.
