Warming Up... If someone lacks self-awareness, they don't recognise their impact on others, they can't see their own patterns, they lack insight in their emotions, they have blind spots about their abilities. 1. Why is self-awareness important? 2. Are there any of these that you feel like you lack self-awareness in?		Aims & Objectives of today's session: - To desire to know Jesus - To think of practical ways to be known by Jesus.
Read John 1:29-42 1. What does this passage say about Jesus and His mission 2. Think about the dialogue exchange between Jesus and the disciples in verse 35-41. What are some observations and thoughts about these conversations? 3. If Jesus asked you "What do you want?" what would you say? 4. Why is Jesus' invitation to come and see important? 5. Why is it significant that Jesus changes Simon's name?	Application 1. What's the difference between knowing what you want, and asking Jesus what we need? Should we ask God for what we want? Or should we ask God to give us what we need? 2. Would you let God redefine you? Your mission, your finances, your relationships? Why or why not? 3. What does it mean for you to be known by Jesus? What does it mean for you to know Jesus?	Having self-awareness is important. But without someone speaking into our life we will struggle to develop that. Because of that, knowing Jesus becomes even more important. If we let Jesus speak into our life, we're inviting him to help us to know Him and to know ourselves. And even more exciting, letting Him transform us. Knowing Jesus has to move beyond just an intellectual pursuit, but into a close relationship.
Read verses 43-50 6. What changes Nathaniel's mind about Jesus? 7. Nathaniel asks Jesus "How do you know me?" What can we see from the passage about how much Jesus knows about Nathaniel.		Homework / Challenge for this week 1. What can you do this week to know Jesus more and to be known by Jesus more. 2. Commit to one change this week
