## GOD ALMIGHTY: MEEKNESS & MAJESTY

*These LifeGroup questions are structured to allow for deeper discussions following on from the Sunday sermon. However, please don't limit yourself to just these questions, feel free to ask more questions as the Spirit leads. May the Spirit lead you and your group to dig deeper into knowing more about God.*

### WARMING UP

1. Have you ever been star-struck in awe by a famous person?  
Who? When?  
Have you ever been in awe of God during worship?  
When? Why? What was the context?  
Is there a difference between being in awe of a famous person vs God?  
Why?

### A HEALTHY DISCUSSION ON MEEKNESS

2. Define the word "meekness" in your own words. Contrast it with a credible online definition.
3. Why would the word "meekness" have weak connotations in this dog-eat-dog world?
4. Read John 13 — Jesus washing the disciples feet
5. Looking at v13, how is Jesus "teacher and Lord"? How did he demonstrate this, in this passage?
6. What implications does Jesus make about this action as an example to his followers? How do Jesus' actions reflect "meekness"? Why?
7. What stops us from serving others today? What terms and conditions do we have? Did Jesus have T&C's?
8. How can we practically demonstrate "meekness" in our workplaces/schools/families?

### A HEALTHY DISCUSSION ON MAJESTY

9. Define the word "majesty" in your own words. Contrast it with a credible online definition.

10. After reading Revelations 4 — distribute some pens and paper, each person spend about 5-10 minutes drawing this scene.
11. How would you react if you saw this vision?
12. What can we learn about the control, the purpose and the origin of the created universe displayed from this vision? What kind of response should this produce in us?
13. From your own limited knowledge, what do the symbolised aspects in this vision signify?
14. What is indicated about God's character here? How does that affect the way in which we ought to worship Him?

### THE POWER OF GOD'S MEEKNESS AND MAJESTY EXEMPLIFIED

15. Read Philippians 2:1-11, list the qualities as presented in this passage, that demonstrate aspects of 'meekness' and/or 'majesty'.
16. How do these qualities exemplify the incarnation and the redemptive work of our Saviour King?
17. How we see God dictates how we react with God. How do you personally see Him? Do you see him as "meek" or "majestic"? Why?

### MOVING FORWARD IN PRAYER

Spend some time as a group worshiping God, picturing John's vision from Revelations, then picturing what you envision heaven to be like.

If no instruments are available, feel free to sing acappella, sing whatever praises of songs come into mind, and freely worship the Lord together through song.

The act of singing together in unison is sung prayers together as a group.
